



## ACI LEARNING IT IMPACT SCHOLARSHIP

**Purpose:** *ACI Learning offers an IT Impact Scholarship that is open to all students that wish to apply. The IT Impact Scholarship was created to support qualified students to continue their educational and career pursuits in the IT industry. Applications are processed through ACI Learning's website application link, and students must apply to be considered. Applications are reviewed weekly via the Scholarship Committee Board comprised of a Leadership group and evaluated based on the information presented in the application. Scholarships are awarded per program start based on seating availability.*

*The IT Impact Scholarship covers the entire cost of a program and recipients are announced weekly after Scholarship Board Committee review.*

### Application Procedure:

- All students wishing to be considered for the merit-based IT Impact Scholarship must apply on the ACI Learning website.
- The application is open to all candidates furthering their education in IT and considering a career in IT.
- The applications are evaluated by the content that the student includes and answers to on the personal statement questions. Application evaluations are reviewed by an Evaluator from the Compliance team using the Scholarship Committee Board approved criteria checklist.
- If the personal statement answers meet the qualifications, the application is presented to the Scholarship Committee Board for final review of the full application and evaluation. The Board is comprised of Leadership from each Campus and members of the Compliance team for additional oversight.
- Applicants are reviewed weekly and awarded as there is space available for qualified applicants. In order to be considered in the final review process, applicants must also meet all applicant and enrollment requirements listed in the ACI Learning Catalog and will be held to the same standards as all other students attending the enrollment cohort.

Applications are held up to six months for further review.

### Eligibility:

Students are eligible to apply for the ACI Learning IT Impact Scholarship if they meet the following requirements:

- Applicant meets the following applicant and enrollment requirements, as stated in the school catalog:
  - Be at least 18 years of age.
  - Applicant has a HS Diploma, GED, or achieves a passing score of 17 on the Wonderlic Scholastic Level Exam.
  - Interview with a Career Training Consultant.
  - Complete an online exam to demonstrate: Basic computer literacy, Basic PC Operation System navigation skills, and Basic Internet usage skills.
- Candidate intends to seek meaningful employment.



**Award:**

- Recipients that are awarded the IT Impact Scholarship will be notified before the start of the selected class-scheduled cohort.
- Recipients will receive a certificate of award from the school.
- Criteria Evaluation Forms for the personal statement answers will be kept in the student record for as long as the record is maintained (Form implemented 5/1/2023).
- The recipient will be required to fill out a student enrollment packet and agree to all terms and conditions.
- Students eligible for the GI BILL<sup>®</sup> have the ability to request BAH through the VA if requested via the option in the application.
